WHAT WE DO

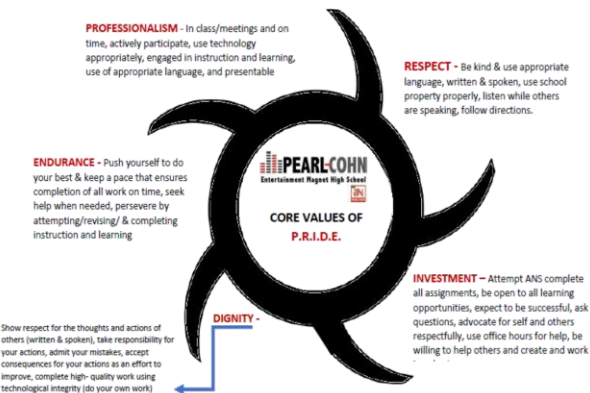

- Being on time, prepared for classroom instruction, provide and receive timely

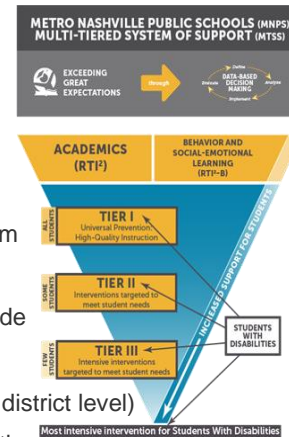
feedback and support to students and families, provide instructional adjustments
